Hitory- Childhood

We will talk about changes over time and use suitable words to sequence events and put them in chronological order.

Writing:

We begin by learning about labels and captions, and writing our own simple labels for things in our classroom, and captions for photos and artefacts linked to our History topic. .

We will look at texts with predictable and patterned language, such as We're Going on a Bear Hunt, and write our own versions.

Text to use - Rhyming texts and texts with repetitive language, which children can join in with.
