## RE Overview People of God

Year 3	Year 6
<p>Pupils will know that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>. The old testament tells the story of a particular group of people, the children of Israel – known as the People of God – and their relationship with God.</li> <li>. The people of God try to live in the way God wants, following his commands and worshipping him.</li> <li>. They believe he promises to stay with them and bible stories show how God keeps his promises.</li> <li>. The Old Testament narrative explains that the People of God are meant to show the benefits of having a relationship with God and to attract all other nations to worshipping God.</li> <li>. Christians believe that, through Jesus, all people can become the People of God.</li> </ul>	<p>Pupils will know that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>. The Old Testament pieces together the story of The People of God. As their circumstances change (for example, from being nomads (Abraham, Jacob) to being city dwellers (David) ) they have to learn new ways of following God.</li> <li>. The story of Moses and the Exodus shows how God rescued his people from slavery in Egypt; Christians see this story as looking forward to how Jesus’ death and resurrection also rescue people from slavery to sin.</li> <li>. Christians apply this idea to living today by trying to serve God and by trying to bring freedom to others: for example, loving others, caring for them, bringing health, food, justice and telling the story of Jesus.</li> <li>. Christians see the Christian Church as part of the ongoing story of the people of God, and try to live in a way that attracts others to God: for example, as salt and light of the world.</li> </ul>
